Terms and Conditions of Membership at UK PADEL

The Rules of UK PADEL

These rules may be subject to change from time to time.

1. UK PADEL is a proprietary club, the proprietor of which is UK Padel Limited.

2. The object of the club is to provide facilities for the playing of Padel Tennis

3. The Membership year will run from date of purchase.

4. Membership of UK PADEL shall be as follows:
 - (i) Adult annual membership
 - (ii) Junior members being under the age of 19 on the first day of the membership year and also active Student Membership

We may from time to time, revoke or vary the categories and terms of membership.

5. Persons who are not members may play as guests with different rights on booking and price.

6. Membership shall be renewed upon payment of the subscription; upon renewal the member shall continue to be subject in full to the rules of the Club.

7. On an ongoing basis all subscriptions shall be payable in advance

8. The subscription rates for the membership year are as follows:

Member £130

Junior Member/ Student £65

9. Any Member wishing to resign from the Club must give written notice of intention to do so at least 14 days before the membership expires.

10. The Proprietor may, in its absolute discretion, expel from the club any member whose conduct is such as shall in the opinion of the proprietor be damaging to the character or interests of the Club.

11. Court fees shall be set from time to time by the proprietor in its absolute discretion.

Court bookings are for periods of 60 or 90 or 120 minutes.

The Court may be booked online via <https://ukpadel.org/uk-padel-clubs/>

or by downloading the UK PADEL app <https://ukpadel.org/app/> - at least one player must register to book

Hours of play are 8.00 a.m. until 10.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday and 9.30am until 8.00pm on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

We reserve the right to review the usage of the courts and make changes to the durations of courts and court fees as necessary.

12. Coaching costs will start as follows:

Coaching (exclusive of court fees)

starting at £52 per hour members / non members £64

The cost of services provided by Coaching Professionals will be reviewed and we reserve the right to make changes as necessary.

13. 24 hours' notice is required for cancellation of a court booking; otherwise full court fees and, if applicable, coaching fees will be charged if the court booking cannot be re-allocated.

14. Access to the courts is via smart access gates, and requires players to register with our UK PADEL app or via the website. The Access code you receive must be retained to allow entry to the courts as they will largely be unmanned

15. Members playing on the last court of the day, should ensure that the gates to the courts are closed, as well as the Padel shack and the main club entrance gate.
16. There is no dress code, other than sports attire. You cannot play topless.
17. Players shall wear clean tennis shoes to avoid damage to the court floor.
18. All members must comply with Health and Safety Regulations which are set out in the Appendix 1.
19. All Members must comply with Child Protection Regulations which are set out in Appendix 2.
20. Car Parking is entirely at members'/visitors' own risk and, subject to members'/visitors statutory rights, Holmer Green Padel accepts no responsibility for any loss or injury to members/visitors and/or their possessions.
21. As a courtesy to neighbours of the club, members are requested to leave the premises quietly.
22. The club is committed to complying with data protection law and to respecting the privacy rights of individuals. The club's members privacy notice Appendix 3 explains how we may use personal information we collect before, during and after your membership with us.
23. Members agree to the use of their images in video and photographic form by the club, including for the purposes of promoting the club, it's events and membership. This includes the use of these images in the club's social media platforms.
24. The proprietor will not accept any claim for loss of or damage to valuables on the club premises other than in accordance with statutory rights.

These rules may be revoked, added to or amended at any time by the proprietor, in its absolute discretion. 22nd July 2025

APPENDIX 1 – HEALTH AND SAFETY REGULATIONS

In joining the club Members agree that they are responsible for themselves and for ensuring that all visitors brought to UK PADEL read, and comply with, the following Health and Safety Regulations:

Players - General Information and Safety Considerations

- Padel Tennis is a strenuous game, players acknowledge that it is their responsibility to ensure they are in appropriate physical condition to play
- The courts are outdoors and unsupervised
- In wet weather the court could be slippery, players must satisfy themselves that the surface is safe.
- In doubles a misunderstanding or mistake could lead to your partner or opposition hitting you with the ball.
- Players accept that UK PADEL accepts no responsibility whatsoever for injury to you or any player on court.

General Policy Statement

UK PADEL is committed to ensuring the Health and Safety of its members, visitors, guests and employees whilst on the Club's courts. It expects all staff and members to share this commitment and inform the club in case of accidents on Club premises.

UK PADEL management will

- Ensure the Club's environment is safe and free from reasonable risk
- Ensure safe entry and exit to our courts
- Maintain a safe court environment for all members, their guests and visitors
- Provide appropriate First Aid facilities
- Discuss Health & Safety with the wider landlords of our clubs

Overall responsibility for Health and Safety in respect of the Club is vested in the Club's Management.

Day-to-day responsibility for ensuring that this policy is put into practice is delegated to the Members, Visitors and Coaches to take reasonable care of their own health and safety while on the Club premises. If at any time there are any health or safety concerns or risks they should be immediately reported.

APPENDIX 2 – CHILD PROTECTION REGULATIONS

Members are responsible for ensuring that all visitors brought to Holmer Green Padel (whether or not to play Padel) read, and comply with, the following Child Protection Regulations. The Welfare officer is Neil Percival.

Under 16s

Those under the age of 16 years, whether or not Members, may not play, spectate or otherwise enter Holmer Green Padel premises without a supervising adult

The supervising adult is responsible for:

ADULT SUPERVISION OF PERSONS UNDER 16 ('Under 16')

- No Under 16 is allowed on UK PADEL premises without being supervised by a parent or guardian or other designated adult, which includes any period when an Under 16 is on court playing or receiving coaching.
- Parents and guardians will ensure that Under 16s and any supervising adults have read, are aware of, and will comply with, Holmer Green Padel Rules, Health and Safety Regulations and Child Protection Regulations.

MEDIA

- Photography and/or video recording of persons under 18 is NOT ALLOWED without the consent of the Under 18's parent or guardian and the consent of UK PADEL. If there is any doubt about whether the person is under 18 please contact the club at hqpadel@ukpadel.org

SOCIAL MEDIA

- Use of UK PADEL social media in relation to Under 18s is NOT ALLOWED without the consent of the Under 18's parent or guardian.
- UK PADEL aspires to maintain the highest standards of behaviour and members are expected to adhere to such standards at all times when using UK PADEL social media.

AWAY MATCHES

- Match managers of away matches should contact UK PADEL Welfare officer, Neil Percival, if any member of the UK PADEL team is an Under 18, as additional child protection provisions apply.

APPENDIX 3 – PROTECTION OF DATA

UK PADEL will hold data relating to each member. This information includes details of a purely administrative nature. The data will be used solely for the purpose of organising Padel activities and related offers as well as contacting members regarding membership. By becoming a member you consent to this data being used in the manner described.

MEDIA

Members' agree to the use of their images in video and photographic form by the club, including for the purposes of promoting the club, its events and membership. This includes the use of these images in the club's social media platforms.

UK PADEL follows LTA guidelines with regard to taking and using photographs of junior members. By joining the club you are consenting to your child being photographed. If you do not wish your child to be photographed please advise in writing.
